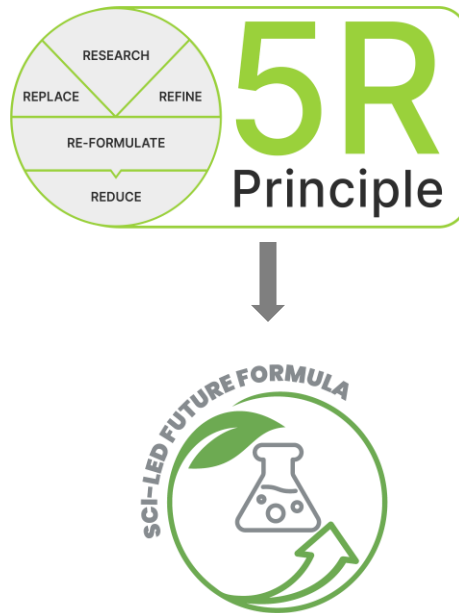

PLANET-CONSCIOUS FORMULATIONS

The older generations at Salvarity stand with the younger generation's desire for a secure future. We're committed to embarking on a long-term journey of steadily adopting practices that minimize environmental impact and safeguard our planet's health. We do this through:

Reducing – Implementing newer generation of ingredients that are safer for human skin and have a lesser impact on the environment. E.g. our thickening system that uses polyacrylate crosspolymer-6 or xanthan gum instead of Carbomer 980, a known microplastic).

Replacing – Using more naturally derived ingredients including Bamboo extract and Abyssinian seed oil.

Refining with:

- ✓ Low footprint materials – drought and frost tolerant; no fertilizer, no pesticide *Salvia* species
- ✓ MBc Herbal Honey – promote bees that are essential to the cycle of life and circular to our herbal flowers
- ✓ Uvalife – utilize by-products from our wine making process, promoting circular economy.



FUNCTIONAL FORMULATIONS

Salvarity products are formulated to address the impacts on teen skin caused by issues they face in their daily activities. From cleansing pollutants and harsh chemicals to repairing the skin barrier.

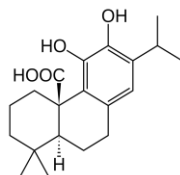
Salvia

- The bees forage from our extensive collection of thousands of all-year-round flowering, medicinal herb varieties and chosen for their valuable skin healing profiles. Examples include Salvia (Sages), Lavender, Rosemary, Thyme, Calendula, Agastache, and many more.
- MBc Herbal has been validated for antioxidant capacity, polyphenol content and antibacterial capacity by Southern Cross University and the Australian Government National Measurement Institute. Its antioxidant level is almost **twice** that of commercial honey (Carlsen, 2010).
- These chemical properties are what gives medicinal honey its abilities in the promotion of skin healing and relief of irritation
- Honey extracts enriched for herbal actives including DHA and MGA show efficacy for controlling the growth of bacteria such as *Cutibacterium acnes*, the main pathogenic factor responsible for acne (Burlando, 2013)

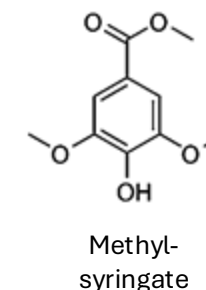
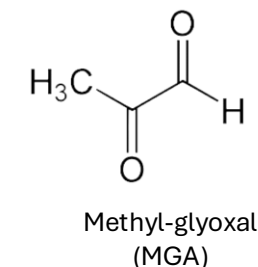
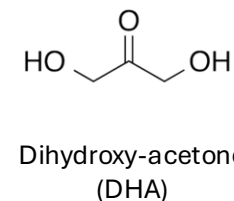

- The substantial antioxidant profile has been validated by Southern Cross University, and the National Measurement Institute of Australia (NMI), including two specific classes of biologically active antioxidants (catechins and anthocyanosides)

Why is the pH of this product slightly lower than others?

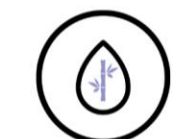

Why is the pH of this product lower than our other products?

The pH of this serum allows the alpha-HA (citric acid) and beta-HA (salicylic acid) to work more effectively in retexturizing skin. Although our products are matched to skin's pH, the slightly lower pH is still within the overall range of skin pH, so it is still safe.

Why isn't it recommended that I use this serum everyday?

This serum has a mild exfoliating and sebum control action, which contributes to a mattifying effect, so it doesn't need to be used everyday. But the product is safe for sensitive skin. Allowing a day in between uses can allow skin to recover its normal regenerative patterns.

What should I use and not use with this product?

The salicylic acid (BHA) in this product is okay to combine with products containing hyaluronic acid, because they both help to improve hydration and reduce potential irritation. Avoid using this product with niacinamide or retinol containing products, as the lower pH can affect how niacinamide and retinol work and can cause redness or irritation.

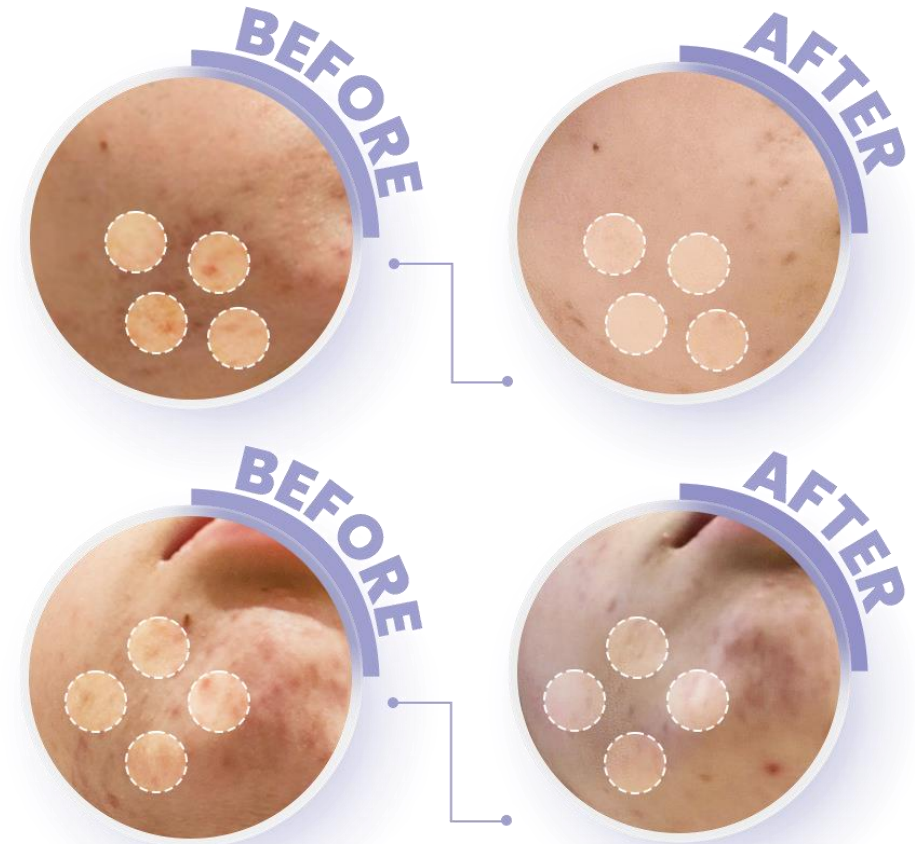

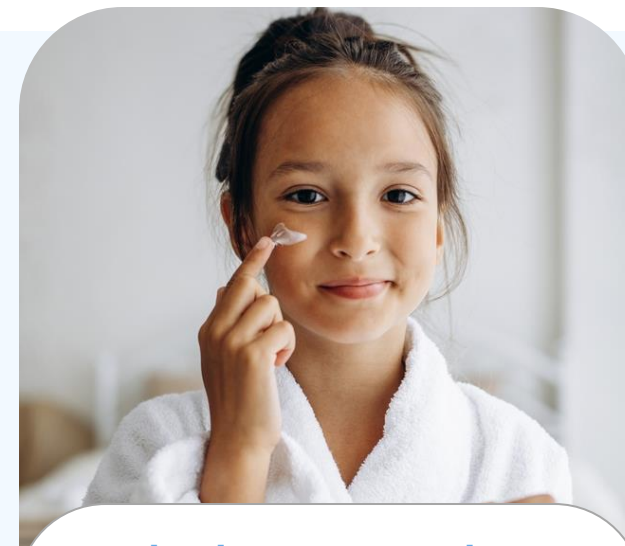

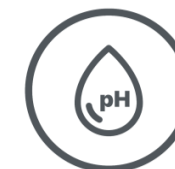

What's the difference between moisturizing and hydrating?

These layers are a natural moisture barrier, made of lipids and skin cells, joined together into a sheet.

Will this moisturizer still work if I have oily or dry skin?

Yes, it will, however, is more suited for teenagers with normal or dry skin type, as it has a slightly higher oil content, but the oils are non-comedogenic and well absorbed. If you have very oily skin, opt for our Mattifying/ Clarifying Moisturizer, which leaves less glossy finish to the skin. 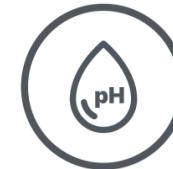

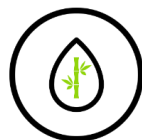

What is meant by anti-redness?

Some skin types are prone to redness, because they are more sensitive and easily irritated, thinner, or lighter complexion. The redness is caused by dilation of the microscopic blood vessels in the deeper layers around the cheeks, nose and forehead, in response to irritation by allergens, inflammation or sun exposure. Anti-redness means that the product is designed to calm skin irritation in those areas, which in turn helps to control redness.

When is the best time of the day to moisturize?

Moisture loss from the skin naturally decreases towards the end of the day, so it makes sense to moisturize at the end of the day, in preparation for sleep when skin repair occurs. 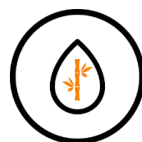

Why is oil control important for teenage skin?

Although skin naturally produces a layer of oil (sebum), it can be a problem with teenage skin, because hormonal changes trigger a rapid increase in sebum during puberty. 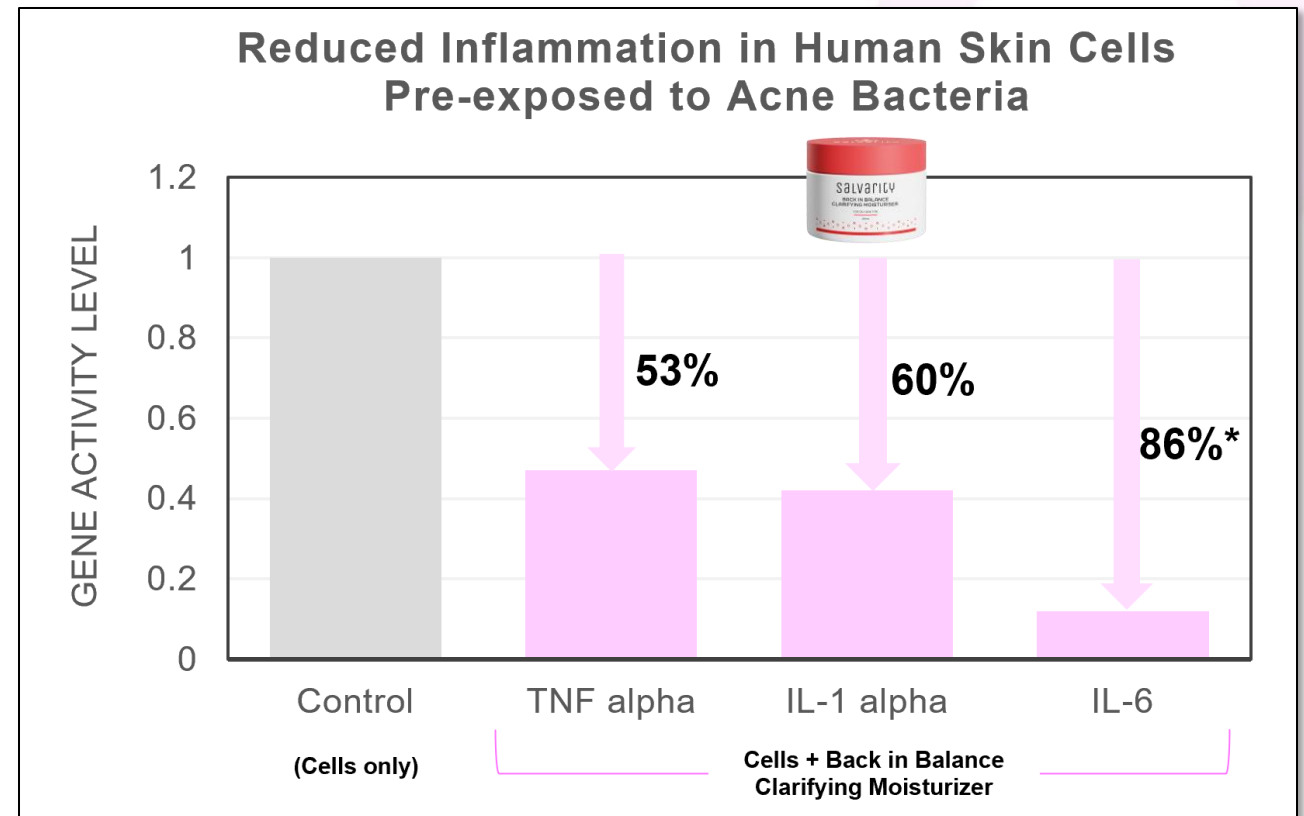

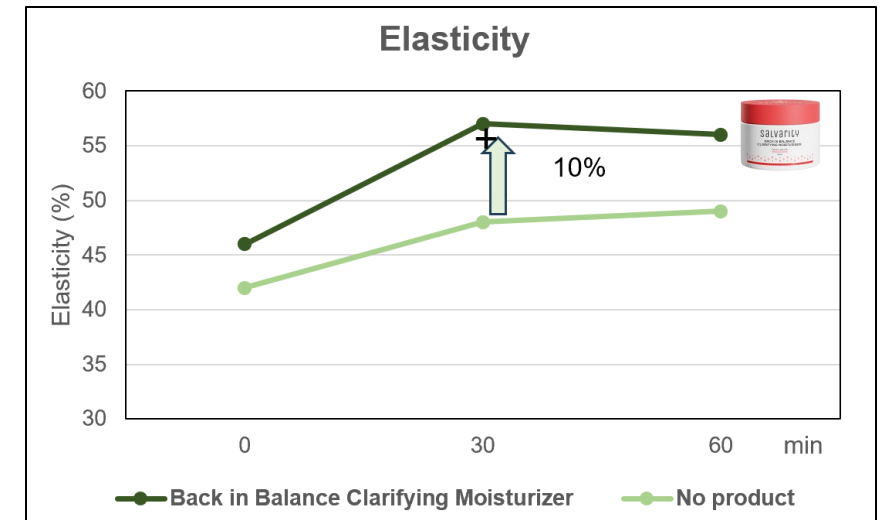
